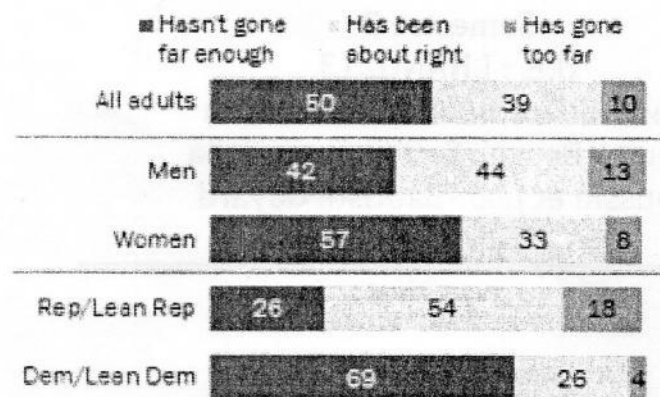

2. Present and briefly comment on the following document. Your comment should be organized and should include a brief presentation of the document, a description, an analysis and a conclusion. (6 pts)



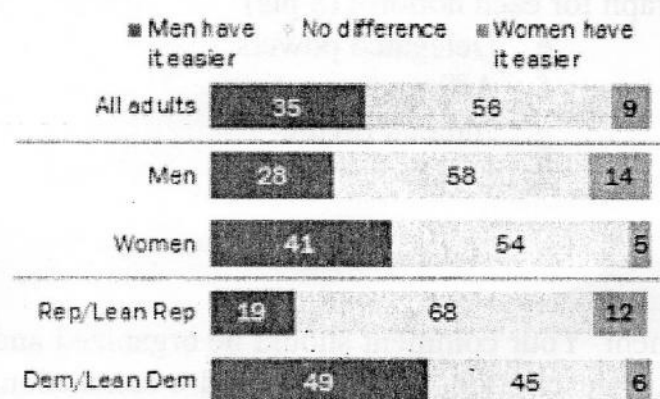

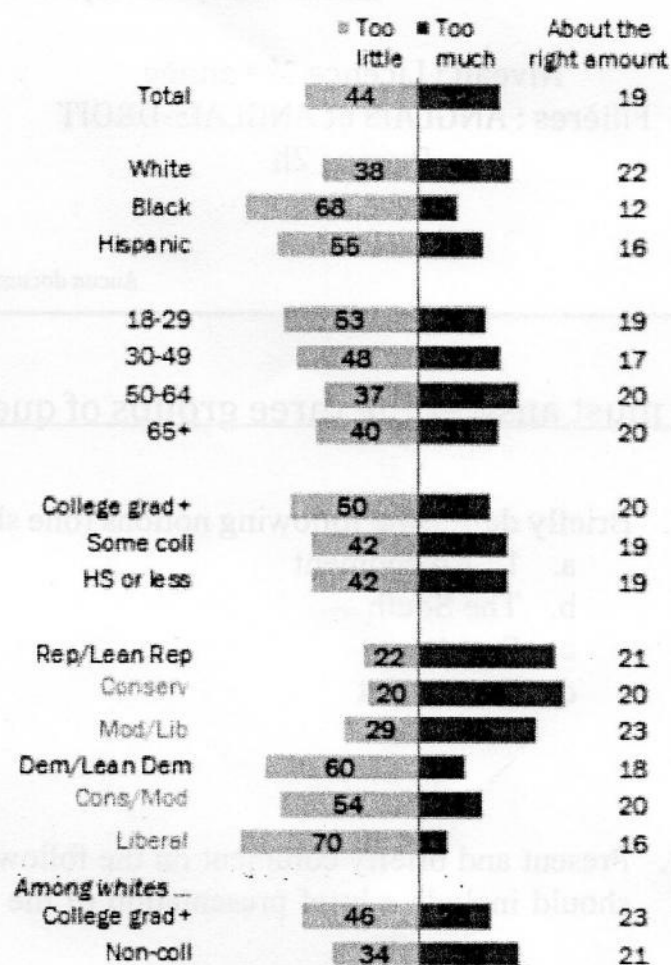
